**CIRCULAR**

As per the approval of the Competent Authority, the Department level final Open Counseling shall be held to fill the vacant seats in UG and PG programmes at IGNTU, Amarkantak. The Departmental Admission Committee constituted as per the Ordinance Number-16 in each Department is authorized to conduct the Open Counseling under the general supervision of the Dean of the Faculty concerned with the following guidelines:

1. Open Counseling shall be held at the Department level on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2018 to fill the remaining seats in UG and PG programs as per the seat matrix and the candidates who have the written entrance examination and secured a minimum of 25 marks (Gen/OBC) can attend the Open Counseling.
2. Candidates shall report at their respective Departments for Open Counseling and produce the duly filled in application forms.
3. The Departments shall take the attendance of all candidates attending Open Counseling.
4. The Departments shall prepare a category-wise selection list of the candidates seeking admission through open counseling and send the same to the office of COE for onward process.
5. Norms of Open Counseling are as follows:
  - A. The eligible candidates shall report to the respective departments between 10.00 AM and 2.00 PM on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2018. The Admission Committee in each Department shall prepare the selection list based on the merit in the entrance exam as per the seat matrix and send the same to the Exam Section by 5.00 PM on 24.08.2018. The selection list shall be announced on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2018.
  - B. The candidates selected through Open Counseling shall appear for the verification of documents on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2018 in the respective Department.
6. **Allotment of Seats** The selected candidates shall pay the admission fee online up to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018.
7. The vacant seats shall be given away to eligible candidates as per the seat matrix and the entire process shall be carried out in three phases:
  - A. In the first phase admissions shall be given to the candidates who wrote exam seeking admission to any programme as their choice.
  - B. In the second phase admissions shall be given (remaining seat, if any) to the candidates who wrote the common entrance exam and the details are as follows:

11	<b>M.Sc. in Physics</b>	A Bachelor degree with Physics as an optional subject from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.
12	<b>M.Sc. in Chemistry</b>	A Bachelor degree in Chemistry or Chemistry as an optional subject at the graduate level from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.

15	<b>i.M.Sc.in Biotechnology ii.M.Sc.in Environmental Science</b>	A Bachelor degree with any one of Life Sciences as an optional subject from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.
16	<b>M.Sc. in Statistics</b>	A Bachelor degree with Statistics/Math as an optional subject from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.
17	<b>M.Sc. in Mathematics</b>	A Bachelor's degree in Mathematics or Mathematics as an optional subject at the graduate level from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.
18	<b>M.C.A.</b>	Candidates having B.C.A/B.Sc./B.Com/B.A. degree with Mathematics as one of the subject at 10+2 level or graduate level from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates

		belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply
19	M.Sc. in Geology	A Bachelor's degree with Geology/Applied Geology/Earth Science as the major subject at the graduate level from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) having secured a minimum of 50% aggregate in case of General and OBC categories and 45% in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories are eligible to apply.

8. **Conversion of Seats:-** If the number of eligible candidates are not available in categories, the seats that remain vacant shall be converted as per the following norms:
- Seats reserved for OBC shall be converted to GEN if there are vacant seats.
  - Seats reserved for SC shall be converted to ST if there are vacant seats and vice versa.
9. The University shall announce the list of eligible candidates and the seat matrix on its website on **20.08.2018**.
10. In case of any candidate(s) claiming admission under PWD/Supernumerary quota, such claims may be sent to the Exam Section separately for onward process.
