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## CIRCULAR

With the approval of the Competent Authority the pass percentage and promotion rules for the UG, Integrated, PG and PhD Programmes have been framed and these rules are applicable to all the students admitted to various programmes for the year 2015-16 under CBCS. The Deans and HOD's are hereby requested to circulate the same among the faculty members working in their faculties and Departments and they are further requested to bring the same to the notice of the students concerned.

1. It was resolved that a student has to score a minimum of 50 marks taking together marks scored in internal and End semester examination to pass a paper which will be called a course from now onwards.
2. It was resolved that a student is required to score 50% of internal marks (20 out of 40) and 50% of end semester exam (30 out of 60) separately to pass a course. If not, then he has to reappear for internals or end semester exam as the case may be when such exams are conducted.
3. It was resolved that a student who appears in an odd semester examinations or who was eligible to appear in the odd semester examinations but remains absent in any or all the papers of the said semester, would move on to the next even semester irrespective of his/her result in the said Examinations.
4. It was resolved that a student who has obtained 50% on the aggregate taking together all the courses in theory examination (including internal assessment/ project work) and practical examination separately conducted in I and II semester shall be promoted to the second academic year i.e.III semester.
5. It was resolved that a student who has obtained 50% on the aggregate taking together all the courses in theory examination (internal assessment/project work) and practical examinations separately, conducted in III and IV semester shall be promoted to the third academic year/ V semester in case of UG programmes.
6. It was resolved that students who do not fulfill the promotion criteria mentioned above shall be declared fail in the promotion examination of the academic year concerned. However, they shall have the option to retain the marks in the papers in which they want to retain.
7. It was resolved that if a student has secured an aggregate of minimum 50% marks taking together all the courses in theory examination (including internal assessment/project, wherever applicable) and practical exam separately till the end of the third year, i.e., up to the end of the VI semester in the case of UG programmes and up to the end of the IV semester in the case of PG programmes, then she/he shall be awarded the degree in which the student has been admitted.
8. It was resolved that any student who is not allowed to write end semester exam for a course for want of attendance has to attend classes in that course to become eligible to write the exam. If he is not allowed to write all the courses in a semester for the same reason, he has to repeat the semester next year i.e. even with even and odd with odd. The Department concerned has to arrange make up classes.
