#### **MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Professor (All Departments except Education, Pharmacy, Management & Yoga)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and /or research/ policy papers.
- A minimum of ten (10) years of teaching experience in University/ College, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- Contribution to education innovation, design of new curricula, courses and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

**OR**

- An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline to be substantiated by credentials.

**Professor - Education**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- A Master's Degree in Arts/Humanities/Sciences/Commerce and M.Ed with a minimum of 55% marks each (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

**OR**

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed with a minimum of 55% marks in each (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

- Ph.D. Degree in Education.
- At least ten (10) years of teaching experience in University Department of Education or College of Education of which a minimum of five years at the M.Ed /MA (Education) level with published work in area of his specialization.
- Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.

- A Ph.D. Degree with First Class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy, and experience of ten (10) years in teaching, research, industry and / or profession at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent grade.

In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential;

- First Class Master's Degree in Pharmacy.
- Significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph.D. Degree in appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy and industrial / professional experience of five years at a senior level comparable to Assistant Professor / Reader, provided that the recognition for significant professional shall be valid only if the same is recommended unanimously by a 3-Member Committee of Experts appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

Demonstrated leadership in planning and organizing academic, research, industrial and / or professional activities; and, 5. Capacity to undertake / lead sponsored R&D, consultancy and related activities.*

## **Professor – Management**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC.

**OR**

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant/Cost and Works Accountant/Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- Ph.D. or Fellow of Indian Institute of Management or of an Institute recognized by AICTE and declared equivalent by the AIU.
- A minimum of ten (10) years of experience in teaching/industry/ research/ professional out of which five years must be at the level of Reader or equivalent excluding the period spent for obtaining the research Degree.

**OR**

- In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC.

- A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/ College, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries.
- Contribution to education innovation, design of new curricula and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

**OR**

- An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline to be substantiated by credentials.

**Associate Professor (All Departments except Pharmacy & Yoga)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/ allied/relevant disciplines.
- A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- A minimum of eight years (08) of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/College or Accredited Research Institutions/Industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) Based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

**Associate Professor - Pharmacy**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- A basic Degree in Pharmacy (B. Pharm).
- Registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948, as amended from time to time, including any succeeding enactments.
- A Ph.D. Degree with First Class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy, and experience of eight years in teaching, research, industry and / or professional at the level of Lecturer or equivalent grade; excluding period spent on obtaining the research Degree.

**OR**

In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential;

- First Class Master's Degree in Pharmacy.
- Significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph.D. Degree in appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy and industrial / professional with a minimum of eight (08) years of experience in a position equivalent to the level of Lecturer, provided that the recognition for significant professional shall be valid only if the same is recommended unanimously by a 3- Member Committee of Experts appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.
- *Desirable: 1. Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization; 2. Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books and / or technical reports; and*

3. Experience of guiding the project work, dissertation of post graduate or research students or supervising R&D projects in industry.

#### **Associate Professor - Yoga**

- Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/ allied/relevant disciplines.
- A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- A minimum of eight years (08) of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/ College or Accredited Research Institution/Industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) Based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

#### **Assistant Professor (All Departments except Education, Management & Yoga)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject or an equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University (Accredited).
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- Candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions in accordance with the permission laid down in the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment of the UGC Regulation, 2010.

#### **Assistant Professor (Education-Mathematics & History)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- A Master's Degree in Mathematics/History and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

**OR**

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET).
- Notwithstanding anything contained above, candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulation 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor, or equivalent position in Universities /Colleges /Institutions.

### **Assistant Professor (Education-Performing Arts)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC. Notwithstanding anything contained in the sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this Clause 4.4.2.1, candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions.
- NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**OR**

A traditional and a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have;

- (a) Studied under noted/reputed traditional masters and has thorough knowledge to explain the subject concerned;
- (b) A high grade artist of AIR/TV; and,
- (c) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

### **Assistant Professor (Education-Fine Arts)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this Clause 4.4.2.3, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions.
- Without prejudice to the above, NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**OR**

- A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have;
  1. First Class Diploma in Visual (Fine) Arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India/Abroad.
  2. Five years of experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence.

3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

### **Assistant Professor (Education-Physical Education)**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University (Accredited).
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- Candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions in accordance with the permission laid down in the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment of the UGC Regulation, 2010.
- Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/such other affiliating body from time to time for the position of Lecturers/ Asst. Professor shall be mandatory.

### **Assistant Professor – Management**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- First Class Masters Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / accredited by the AICTE / UGC.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- Candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions in accordance with the permission laid down in the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment of the UGC Regulation, 2010.  
*Desirable: 1. Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization; 2. Paper presented at Conferences and / or published in refereed journal.*

### **Assistant Professor – Yoga**

**Pay Scale-** As per UGC Norms

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC. Candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.



- A minimum of 55% marks in Master Degree (Yoga) and NET/SLET/SET in Yoga.

**OR**

- A minimum of 55% marks in Master Degree (Yoga) + Ph.D. in Yoga.

**OR**

- Master Degree in any discipline with 55% of marks + Ph.D. in Yoga\*.

(\* Considering the paucity of teachers in the newly emerging field of yoga this alternative has been provided, and will be valid only for five years from the date of this notification)

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- 1) The direct recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor in the University shall be on the basis of merit through all India advertisement, screening and selections by the duly constituted Selection Committees in accordance with the provisions given in the UGC Regulations/NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as the case may be) as amended from time to time, and provisions given in the University Act/Statutes/Ordinances/Rules etc.
- 2) Candidate must bring all original Degree Certificates and Mark Sheets, Testimonials, Certificates relating to his/her Age, Experience, API and Caste etc. at the time of interview. In case the candidate fails to submit the original documents for verification of the certified/photocopies of the enclosures to his/her application, he or she shall not be allowed to appear for the interview and his candidature shall be treated as cancelled without any further communication in this regard.
- 3) The University may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview as per the rules for this purpose to a reasonable number on the basis of Qualification, Experience, higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit.
- 4) The Selection procedure shall be as laid down by the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Others Academic staff in University and Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education-2010 as amended from time to time.
- 5) Relaxation in percentage of marks etc. may be applicable to the candidates belonging to the Schedule Caste (SC)/Schedule Tribes (ST)/OBC/PWD or other reserved categories as per the UGC guidelines. A certificate to this effect issued from the competent authority should be attached with the prescribed application form. If the relevant certificates in case of respective reserved categories are not attached with the application, the application shall be rejected and no appeal will be entertained.
- 6) Experience and qualification will be considered as on the last date of submission of application.
- 7) Candidates intending to apply for different posts are required to apply separately.
- 8) In absence of hard copy of online application form along with self-attested necessary supporting documents, the candidature shall not be considered for screening.
- 9) No TA/DA will be paid for attending interview before the selection committee. However, the out-side candidate belonging to SC/ST/PWD categories will be admissible for second class rail fare (shortest route), and in case any station is not connected by rail subject to production of original tickets of ordinary bus fare shall be paid (shortest route) as per the guidelines of the UGC/ Govt. of India rule. Extra charges (if any) incurred for reserving seat/sleeping berth in the train will not be reimbursed to the candidates.

- (iii) The name of the candidate, Date of Birth and his / her Parents' name etc. should be written correctly in the online application in **BOLD LETTERS** as it appears in the class 10<sup>th</sup> certificate. Any changes / alteration found may disqualify the candidature.

11) **OTHER CONDITIONS:**

- (i) Mere possession of eligibility conditions shall not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. The date for determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be the closing date as prescribed in the advertisement for receipt of the applications. In other words no candidate shall be called for interview if he/she does not possess the minimum qualification and experience etc. as on the last date of the application for a particular post.
- (ii) Candidate who is already in service should submit his/her application through proper channel. However, he/she may send an advance copy of his/her application and should produce a **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** from the employer at the time of interview failing which he/she shall not be entertained for the interview.
- (iii) It is the responsibility of the candidate to assess his own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualification, experience etc and submit his/her application duly filled-in along with desired information, documents and other supporting materials as per the advertisement. Suppression of factual information, production of fake documents, providing false or misleading information or any other undesirable action by the candidate shall lead to cancellation of his candidature. In case, it is detected at any point of time in future even after appointment that the candidate was not eligible as per the prescribed qualification, experience, etc. which could not be detected at the time of interview due to whatever

- circumstances, his/her appointment shall be liable to termination forthwith as per this clause without any notice and also based on his undertaking.
- (iv) Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for updates related to recruitment.
  - (v) (a) The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill up the posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever.
    - (b) The University reserves the right to withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to this effect.
    - (c) The University reserves the right to increase or decrease or withdraw the vacancies according to the circumstances.
    - (d) Interim enquiries shall not be entertained.
    - (e) **Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidature of the candidate.**
    - (f) Applicants are required to apply online separately for each post.
  - (vi) API format as per the UGC 2010 guidelines- 4<sup>th</sup> Amendment dated July 11, 2016.
  - (vii) The decision of the screening committee is final with regard to screening of applications and short listing of the candidates for appearing interview.
  - (viii) Salary and super annuation will be according to the UGC norms from time to time.
