Funding Agency: Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), Govt. of India.

Minimum Qualification for JRF: M. Sc. or equivalent degree with at least 55% marks, in Zoology/Biotechnology/Biochemistry/life sciences and have qualified NET(JRF/LS)/GATE/national level equivalent exam in Life Sciences.


Age Limit: The upper age limit for JRF shall be 28 years.

Age relaxation for JRF: upper age limit is relaxation is up to 5 years for SC/ST/Women candidates.

Remuneration for JRF: NET/GATE qualified candidates: Rs. 31,000 per month + 08% HRA. However Non-NET/GATE candidates can also apply who will be selected as per Project Assistant, SERB, GOI rules. However, NET (JRF/LS)/GATE/national level equivalent exam in Life Sciences qualified candidate will be preferred.
