1. Candidate should fill the attendance sheet.

3. Candidate should bring the copy of Score card which has provided by the NTA and IGNTU registration form.
4. Candidate should verify the guideline and their eligibility intended course/programme in second open counselling.
  1. No age limit for admission in UG, PG and diploma courses.
  2. First Preference will be given to the candidates who have written the NTA/CUET Examination of the Domain subject/Paper code for the particular programme. (Mapping of Domain subject and paper code attached )
  3. Second preference will be given to the candidates who have secured any highest marks of any Domain subjects except language test (i.e. Hindi, English or any other languages).
  4. For UG/Diploma Programme consider as normalized score which has given to the candidate's Score card.
  5. For PG Programme consider as Total marks/Percentile score which has given to the candidate's Score card which has given to the candidate's Score card.
