Circular

As per the approval of the Competent Authority, the Department level Open Counseling shall be held to fill the vacant seats in Diploma, UG, B.Ed. and PG programme at IGNTU, Amarkantak & IGNTU-RCM. The Departmental Admission Committee to be constituted by the Head of the Department and is authorized to conduct the Open Counseling with the following guidelines:

1. Open Counseling shall be held at the Department level on 29/11/2022 for Diploma and UG and on 30/11/2022 for PG & BE.d. programmes to fill the remaining seats in Diploma, UG, BE.d. and PG programmes as per the seat matrix and the candidates who have appeared in written CUET entrance examination and registered in Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (through Samarth Portal), secured a minimum CUET/NTA Score as per the table given below and has eligibility criteria as per the university norms, can attend the Open Counseling.

1. Eligible candidates shall report at their respective Departments for Open Counseling, along with following documents
 - (a) 10th(HSc) /12th (HSSc) Marksheet.
 - (b) UG Marksheet.
 - (c) Caste certificate (if applicable)
 - (d) IGNTU (CUET) Application Form
 - (e) CUET score card
2. The Departments shall take the attendance of all candidates attending Open Counseling.
3. The Departments shall prepare a category-wise selection list of the candidates seeking admission through Open Counseling as on the seat matrix (**Annexure A**) and send the same to the office of the Admission cell for onward process.
4. Norms of Open Counseling are as follows:

- (a) The eligible candidates shall report to the respective Departments between 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM on 29 & 30/11/2022. The admission committee in each Department shall prepare the selection list and waiting list based on the merit of the appeared candidates and seat matrix. Selection and waiting list should be submitted to the Admission section by 4.00 PM of 29 November 2022 to 30 November 2022 for further process and the selection list shall be announced by Next day.
- (b) The candidates selected through Open Counseling shall pay the admission fee online till 05-12-2022 and the candidate will appear for the verification of Documents till 06-12-2022 in the respective Departments.
- (c) Instructions to the provisionally selected candidate (through Open Counselling) for document verification (**Annexure B**)

Any irregularity committed while furnishing the information to the University by the candidate then the admission of the candidate will be cancelled for which he/she shall solely be responsible and no correspondence shall be entertained.
- IV. Candidates are advised to bring the following items for their convenience {Ball Point Pen and four (4) colour photograph (for admission forms), Personal hand sanitizer and mask.}
- V. Candidate should also follow instructions which are given by the Proctor Office of the University while entering the University Campus.
