Applications are invited from suitable candidates for the positions of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) (01) in an ICMR-funded research project entitled “Roles of folic acid on the expression and regulation of FOXP2 in F1 progeny of perinatal folic acid fed pregnant mouse” under the supervision of Dr Vijay Paramanik (PI-ICMR project).

Duration of the Project: Three years. The initial appointment of the JRF stands for one year and may be extended after satisfactory work/research progress.

Nature of the Post: Purely temporary and essentially co-terminus with the tenure of the project.

Essential Qualifications: Master degree (with minimum 55% marks) in Zoology/Biochemistry/ Bioscience/ Life Sciences/ Biotechnology/ NET (LIFE Sciences) /GATE/ national level equivalent exam. The exemption is applicable as per GOI rules.

Age Limit: The upper age limit of JRF is 28years. However, a relaxation of 5years is applicable for SC/ST/ women candidates.


Monthly Fellowship amount: Rs. 31000 with 9% HRA (Rs 33790)
